TREE PROGRAM POLICY

Trees and shrubs must be watered immediately after planting. Trees and shrubs should be soaked to the depth of eight (8) inches, and at least twice during the first year if there is a shortage of moisture. The planting should also be watered in the fall before frost if needed.

TREE REPLACEMENT POLICY

Trees and shrubs purchased from Lyon Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) have the following guarantee. For those that have failed to start they must be reported to us no later than September 1 of the planting year. These trees will be replaced at one-half the cost. Trees that have been damaged due to drought, drowning, animals or poor care will not be replaced by the District. Trees planted in sod will not be guaranteed. The SWCD technician will visit the site and inspect the planting.

Keeping the trees growing and maintained is the responsibility of the landowner.

TREE PLANTING / MATTING POLICY

Lyon SWCD provides the service of planting trees. The service is at the following charges:

- \$.30 cents per bare root tree or shrub
- \$ 1.00 per 1 gallon potted tree
- Minimum planting charge of \$ 75.00 for all plantings
- \$ 30.00 per hour charge to plant trees that the SWCD did not sell – \$ 50.00 per hour for each hour after first 8 hours. Minimum charge of \$75
- Landowner provides tractor and driver as well as additional manpower as needed. SWCD Staff will operate the planter.
- Lyon SWCD will lay **TREE MATTING** for a charge of .05 cents per foot ~ with edge seeding .10 cents per foot Under 1,500 ft a minimum \$75 will be charged.

PAYMENT POLICIES

- Tree Orders over \$ 50.00 require a down payment at time of order (30% of total, less sales tax)
- Tree Orders under \$ 50.00 must be paid in full (including applicable sales tax)
- Deciduous trees are sold in bundles of 25 only!
- A service charge of 1.5% per month, 18% annually will be charged on outstanding bill.
This charge will be in effect for all bills not paid by September 1 of the planting year.
Trees that were not planted by the SWCD **balance is due** when picked up, service charges will accrue if not paid for within 30 days of pick-up.

IMPORTANT

All trees sold by the District are species that have been designated hardy to this region by the Natural Resources Conservation Service Forestry Staff. All trees are purchased through nursery's that are inspected by the MN Dept. Of Ag and certified as disease free. A list of the suppliers is available from the SWCD.
